

SPECIFIC HISTORY FOR: ACID REFLUX

¹ The claimant reports being diagnosed with GERD. ² The condition has existed since 2002. ³ The condition does not affect general body health. ⁴ Over the past 6 months the claimant has lost 15 lbs. ⁵ The claimant reports heartburn, epigastric pain, scapular pain, passing of black-tarry stools, reflux and regurgitation of stomach contents and nausea and vomiting. ⁶ He has no dysphagia, arm pain and haematemesis. ⁷ The symptoms described occur intermittently, as often as 3 times a day, with each occurrence lasting several hours. ⁸ The number of attacks within the past year was 100. ⁹ The ability to perform daily functions during flare-ups is occasionally lies down during severe flares. ¹⁰ The treatment is Nexium, Prilosec. The claimant reports he never was hospitalized nor had any surgery for this condition. ¹¹ The claimant reports the following overall functional impairment(s): difficulty concentrating during severe flares

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SPECIFIC HISTORY FOR: IRRITABLE BOWEL SYNDROME

¹ The claimant reports being diagnosed with GERD. ² The condition has existed since July 2002. ³ The condition is not due to injury or trauma. ⁴ The condition affects general body health by weight, appetite, diet. ⁵ Over the past 6 months the claimant has lost 15 lbs. ⁶ For his intestinal condition, he has nausea and vomiting and diarrhea. ⁷ He has no chronic constipation and alternating diarrhea and constipation. ⁸ Specifically, the symptoms occur For IBS, bouts of diarrhea gas, lower GI pressure. ⁹ He reports abdominal pain located abdomen. ¹⁰ It occurs more than 2/3 of the year. ¹¹ The abdominal pain has the characteristic of distress. ¹² The symptoms described occur constantly. The treatment is Malox. The claimant reports he never was hospitalized nor had any surgery for this condition. Additionally the claimant indicates the following: GERD The claimant reports the following overall functional impairment(s): have to plan accordingly, frequent bathroom stops while driving.

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
