DECISION

- 1. Service connection for anxiety disorder (not otherwise specified) is granted with an evaluation of 50 percent effective November 16, 2012.
- 2. Service connection for chronic fatigue syndrome is granted with an evaluation of 20 percent effective November 15, 2013.
- 3. Service connection for keratoconus is granted with an evaluation of 10 percent effective November 16, 2012.
- 4. Evaluation of gastritis (claimed as heartburn) with GERD, hiatal hernia and Baret's esophagus, which is currently 0 percent disabling, is increased to 30 percent effective November 16, 2012.
- 5. Evaluation of residuals, post operative right (minor) shoulder, which is currently 10 percent disabling, is increased to 20 percent effective November 16, 2012.
- 6. Basic eligibility to Dependents' Educational Assistance is established from November 15, 2013.
- 7. Evaluation of left upper lobe granuloma, which is currently 0 percent disabling, is continued.
- 8. The previous denial of service connection for migraine headaches (formerly tension headaches) is confirmed and continued.
- 9. The claim for service connection for sleep apnea remains denied because the evidence submitted is not new and material.
- 10. The claim for service connection for left ankle condition remains denied because the evidence submitted is not new and material.
- 11. The claim for service connection for right ankle condition remains denied because the evidence submitted is not new and material.
- 12. The claim for service connection for dry skin on the elbows remains denied because the evidence submitted is not new and material.
- 13. Service connection for asthma (unspecified respiratory condition) is denied.
